



Authority through Relation - Parental Presence as a systemic concept

- Creation of non-violent realities
- Appreciation, respect good intentions
- Linguistic alliances a matter of attitude and choosing words
- Body language
- Parental Presence
- Translation of values, reframings, dilemmata
- Interventions (Announcement, sit-in, self control, supporters, reconciliation gestures)
- Escalations pattern
